Rec Crew Facts & Commitment

Serving on the Rec Crew Ministry Team is a privilege and a great responsibility. Wearing the “orange shirt” is more than just running the games, cleaning up, and having a good time. It’s about ministry to the youth who will be attending the camp, being a good example during play time and worship, and being involved on the prayer team. As Rec Crew members, you will also be called on to share your testimony and devotionals to other groups so you should be prepared and willing to be used when offered this opportunity. Rec Crew members must lead by example.

Each member of the Rec Crew Team must be able to meet the following requirements:

1. Be a high school graduate
2. Be available without exception for the entire week of Rev Camp, the Sunday (before camp) through Saturday (last day of camp). If you are not available the entire week, please see the Camp Director to modify your commitment schedule. See the Calendar on the last page to indicate your availability for this camp.
3. Have a desire to work in ministry on some level.
4. Faithfully attend and complete requirements of the Victory Intern discipleship program. If work/school schedule does not permit the participation in the intern program, please see the Camp Director for a modified version of the program.
5. Faithfully attend all pre-camp preparation and planning meetings.

Being a part of the Rec Crew will allow you to receive hands-on ministry experience, develop and increase your leadership skills, and learn what it really means to be a servant. We are looking for hard working, servant minded people who can make things happen - even if it is just behind the scenes. This program will test your endurance and your ability to maintain a great attitude.

What is Provided: Lodging, meals, snacks. You will be required to purchase a \$10 Camp T-shirt.

Camp Rules: 1. Shorts must be at least mid-thigh. No leggiings or bootie shorts allowed. Ladies may wear jeans, slacks or capri pants to the evening services. Young men must wear pants or shorts to the evening services (no athletic attire). Abbreviated attire such as half shirts, tank tops, sundresses, spaghetti straps, halter-tops or crop shirts will not be allowed. Girls must wear swimsuits under clothes for all outdoor activities. Everyone must wear closed-toed shoes during all outside activities. 2. No fireworks, tobacco, illegal drugs, etc. 3. No shaving cream unless used for shaving.

What to Bring:

A good attitude
Bible, Pen, Notebook (No electronic bibles allowed)
Pillow
Twin sized air mattress OR a sleeping cot
Sleeping bag OR sheets and a blanket
Two pairs of closed toed shoes (they will get wet and muddy)
Clean, dry shoes for evening services
Underwear and socks
Clothes that can get dirty (no tank tops or short shorts)
Swim Suit/Suits (to be worn under clothing for water games)
Clothes for evening services
Modest pajamas
Towels and washcloths
Sunglasses/Sunscreen
Flashlight
Dirty clothes bag
Toiletries (shampoo, deodorant, toothbrush, etc.)
Medications (to be checked in with the nurse)

A few NOTES:

** We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

** There will be an "electronics fast" during camp. No cell phones, iPods, games, etc. will be allowed during camp.

** Clothing - Our goal for dress at camp revolves around modesty. Shorts can be worn during the day but must be at least mid-thigh. Athletic shorts or cheerleader shorts like those worn in gym class should not be worn.

**Abbreviated attire such as half shirts, tank tops, sundresses, spaghetti straps, halter-tops, or crop shirts will not be allowed. This includes shirts with sides ripped out. No basketball jerseys without undershirts are allowed. All clothing must cover shoulders, back, sides and navels at all times. Shoes must be worn at all times. Closed toed shoes must be worn during all outside activities -- No exceptions!!

**Recreation during the day is often messy! When planning what clothes to bring, you will want to bring older clothes and shoes that you can get wet, muddy and dirty! Ladies must wear a bathing suit under their clothing during the outside activities. Pajamas are not allowed for recreation activities.

** It gets really hot in the summer and you will be spending a lot of time outdoors
- Please keep this in mind when packing.
